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Few topics among men are as polarizing as... camping. Some love it and live for it. Some hate it and avoid it. I believe that there are things about us as men (probably women too, but I can't be certain because I'm not one) that will not be unlocked unless we make our peace with camping. I'm not talking about backpacking into the woods with only a bag of granola and recycled TOMS shoes. I'm just talking about being outside with no bed and absent of central heat/air.

Strong words, I know – but they come from a former camping hater. Six years ago, I took my son on a bike trip out west and knew I couldn't afford gas, food, and hotel for two people so we camped. Spending 7 days straight around a campfire and in a tent changed me and my perspective. That trip has led to roughly 200 nights camping since; put simply, I've become a camping evangelist. Here's why...

CAMPING BUILDS MEMORIES.

Remember that time you stayed at a Holiday Inn and watched SportsCenter? Of course not. But I remember and still talk about the trip when we had cheap gear and were on the edge of a gorge and the

wind kicked up and pancaked our tent on top of the two of us.

CAMPING BUILDS IDENTITY.

Humanity has been camping for most of its history. Camping enables us to have a primal connection to pioneers and settlers – men with a toughness – that the average male today simply doesn't have.

CAMPING BUILDS CAMARADERIE.

The average male is isolated. Our technology has enabled us to be isolated because we don't need anyone else. But in the process, we isolate ourselves and become cut off from truly needing other people. Camping is a communal effort. Someone gathers firewood, someone starts the fire, someone breaks out the food, people help each other with their tents or a structure to shield the rain, etc. This activity is a springboard into lasting friendship.

CAMPING BUILDS HARDINESS.

We rode to Alaska a few years ago and it was difficult. There is nothing fun about taking down a tent in the driving rain and then setting that

same wet tent up 9 hrs later in a driving rain. But at the end of that trip, I had crossed over into a new territory of hardiness. Things that stressed me out or intimidated me before the trip didn't bother me anymore. I knew I could get through it.

CAMPING BUILDS CONFIDENCE.

When a man learns to build a fire to stay warm, to keep himself sustained without fast food, or figures out how to mend a broken tent pole he becomes a problem solver. Problem solvers have a right to have confidence which gives them a leg up on whatever the future may hold.

Camping scratches something deep inside of us. It produces something different in our character. When we return to civilization, we do so with a changed identity. It is the way it has always been and we would do well to emulate the men who have gone before us in every time period and on every continent.

“ *One of the biggest mistakes I've ever made was not getting my family to camp when we were younger.* ”

It spurs teamwork, conversations, character, laughter, and memories that no hotel ever will. I encourage you to try it. Make it an easy start. Load up your car with a bunch of food, blankets, and firewood and park it at a sanctioned park where there is a fire ring and restrooms nearby. You can use the wet wipes in the woods the next time.

This isn't a kumbaya-singing, sit-and-get church camp. You'll be challenged physically, mentally, and spiritually. It's a BYO-Everything weekend, including food. You'll hike all of your gear in with your unit over challenging terrain to find and establish camp.

Everything throughout the weekend is designed for maximum impact, even downtime.

If done right, you'll come home both refreshed and tired. In the best possible way.

This year's theme: THE COMMISSIONING.

A fresh experience to find new direction and awaken your purpose. Be the man God made you to be.

"I spent the weekend with 8 men that I never met before Friday and I can honestly call those men friends now. Scratch that, those men are my brothers now."



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WOMAN CAMP: SET FREE

FAQS GEAR UP

WHERE DO WE CAMP?

At Base Camp.* It's 430 beautiful acres of rolling hills and forest about 45 minutes east of Cincinnati, owned and maintained by Crossroads.

* The exceptions to all this are Student Camps and the Senior Getaway. Student Camps happen at Bowling Green State University, and Senior Getaway happens at Higher Ground Campground.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

At a minimum you'll need your own sleeping bag, a camp chair, headlamp, water bottle, and something to eat on. You'll work with your pre-assigned unit to figure out big stuff like tents and coolers. For some camps (like MAN CAMP), you hike in and out over a mile with everything you pack. Others (like Family Camp), you can drive right up to your campsite.

WHAT IF I DON'T HAVE CAMPING GEAR?

You'll be assigned a group at every camp. Nobody goes alone. This will be your crew for the weekend. You'll share a campfire, meal prep, and any gear needs. You solve everything as a team. Even if you're the indoorsy type, there's a whole crew of people that will have your back.

I'VE ALREADY BEEN TO A CAMP. WHY SHOULD I GO BACK?

You ever have a great steak dinner and decide, "Welp, that's enough of that, guess I'm a vegan now"? Is that one time you worked out in high school "plenty"? Do you crush your numbers in Q1 and then coast the rest of the year? Well, all of that is just dumb. If you've been to camp and hated it, cool. It might not be for you. If you liked it you know that there is something incredibly special that happens there. You may not think you need to go again, but there is more for you there. Every single camp hits different. Each time is a unique experience since YOU are a huge part of creating the experience. If you're ready to step up and lead at camp, you absolutely should. You could even try a different camp. There are tons of options.

Getaways

So we’ve got this amazing 430 acres of land just east of Cincinnati. Why not use it more often? We’re working this year to create fresh experiences where people can get away to experience God and connect with other like-minded folks. We created a whole new bucket of events called Getaways. ***These things are so fresh we haven’t even planned them all yet.*** But here are some of the ideas we’re thinking about:

CAMP WITH YOUR CREW	Reserve a spot to camp with your group, your friends, or your family. We supply the land, BYO-Everything else.
OVERLANDING GETAWAY	Meet up with other folks who do overlanding, even if you’re just interested in the idea. Learn about gear, how to cook a great meal where there’s no cell reception, and practice marshaling (navigating obstacles in a vehicle as a team).
BASE CAMP DRIVE-IN	Watch a movie under the stars and camp.
MEDICAL GETAWAY	Medical professionals deal with a lot of things that regular folks don’t. We’re working on an event where doctors, nurses, first responders, and other people in the medical field can get healing and rest.
OVERNIGHTS FOR CAMP LEADERS	If you’ve ever served at a camp, we’re working on overnights where you can actually be off and get inspired for your next leadership move.

- >> **Build community:** Camps are only the beginning. We’ve got a ton of opportunities to get people into meaningful relationships after camp events, and we need leaders to make it happen.

>> **Prayer team:** Maybe the single most powerful piece of a camp is what happens under the prayer tent. See God move in powerful ways when you serve.

>> **Work on the land:** Get your hands dirty and prepare the way for God to meet people at camps.
