Hauser & Wirth Menorca is an art centre combining art, education and conservation in the natural setting of Illa del Rei. The art centre presents an ambitious exhibition programme accompanied by a dedicated public programme with learning and conservation at its core. Outdoor sculptures are found amid the natural landscape and the garden designed by Piet Oudolf.

Discover ‘Directionless’ a group exhibition organized by Rashid Johnson, which brings together the work of 28 international artists.

FUNDACIÓ HOSPITAL DE L'ILLA DEL REI

The foundation, a dedicated international group of volunteers, has spearheaded the recovery of the naval hospital on Illa del Rei since 2004. Built by the British in 1711, the hospital is now home to a museum celebrating the site's 300-year history and the harbour's Interpretation Centre.

Hauser & Wirth Menorca is located on Illa del Rei, an island of Mahon harbour accessible via a shuttle boat service. The shuttle boat departs from Moll de Llevant 61 in Mahon.

DIRECTIONLESS

ORGANIZED BY RASHID JOHNSON

21 JUNE – 25 OCTOBER

‘Directionless’ is a sweeping group exhibition organized by artist Rashid Johnson. The project begins with the recognition that we are living through a period marked not only by profound disorientation, but by exhaustion. Political certainties have frayed, collective narratives have weakened, ecological anxieties deepen, and inherited systems of meaning no longer provide stable points of orientation. In such a condition, directionlessness emerges not as a temporary loss of bearings but as a defining experience of contemporary life. The exhibition asks what forms of thought, feeling, and artistic practice become possible when certainty is no longer available and when exhaustion itself has become a shared social condition.

EDUCATION LAB: BITÁCORA

This year’s Education Lab, ‘Bitacora,’ is developed in collaboration with the University of the Balearic Islands and the University of Barcelona. The student-led program nurtures national connectivity between the universities, exploring what learning looks like beyond an institutional setting and facilitating a launchpad for creating, sharing and collaborative research. Responding to the themes of the group exhibition ‘Directionless,’ the Education Lab echoes the very concept set by Rashid Johnson, to find new creative pathways and orientations through artistic practice.

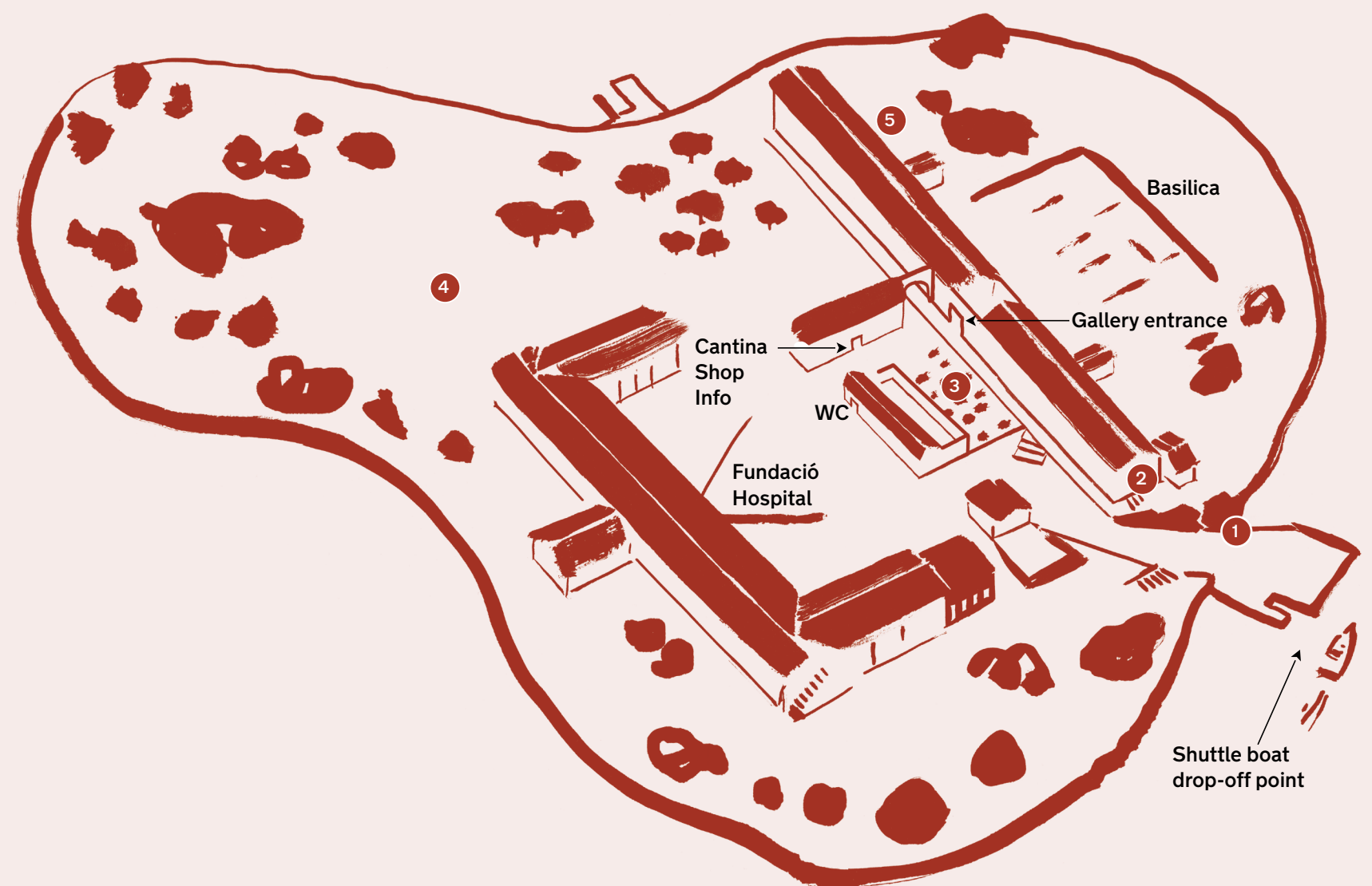

CANTINA

Cantina is a convivial restaurant and bar with a focus on sharing, local produce and Menorca’s rich gastronomic traditions. Operated by Artfarm, Iwan and Manuela Wirth’s independent hospitality company, Cantina serves seasonal vegetables and sharing plates of fish, rice dishes and grilled meats. While the kitchen is located in the historical building that once housed the hospital’s cooking area, the restaurant and bar are outdoors. Tables are found amid an olive grove with views of the harbour and surrounding nature.

GARDEN BY PIET OUDOLF

A garden designed by Piet Oudolf runs alongside the gallery buildings incorporating native perennials and planting suited to the climate. A matrix of graceful low growing grasses leads to various types of bright shrubs in a sustainable garden that enhances the ever-changing experience of the Mediterranean landscape.



SUSTAINABILITY



In line with the Paris Climate Agreement of the United Nations, we are committed to reducing our carbon emissions by at least 50% by 2030. We have already implemented several sustainability initiatives on site, which include:

- Using 100% renewable energy
- Joining the Plastic Free Commitment to become a Plastic Free Island
- Collecting rainwater for use in our gardens
- Installing a free public fountain
- Using low energy LED lights in our galleries and offices
- Using outdoor lights controlled by motion and daylight sensors

BIODIVERSITY



Illa del Rei is a protected natural environment with unique biodiversity, including the native species of lizard ‘*Podarcis lilfordi balearica*’. They find shelter in

newly created grooves across the building and Piet Oudolf’s sustainable garden.
